Accommodation:

The participants will be accommodated in 2-bedrooms in **Hotel Tehnograd, Goste Lazerevića bb, Tuzla**. Hotel Tehnograd is a 3 star hotel, renovated in 2011 and consists of 4 floors with a capacity for 150 people. Each room has private bathroom. Bed linens and towels are provided. Hotel offers to its guests free Wi-Fi in common areas and rooms, telephone, private parking under video surveillance for hotel guests, cable TV in rooms, and a cozy and warm atmosphere during your stay at the hotel Tehnograd. Breakfast, lunches and dinners as well as 2 coffee breaks per day will be provided by organizers.

About Tuzla:

Tuzla is a city in Bosnia and Herzegovina. It is the seat of the Tuzla Canton and is the economic, scientific, cultural, educational, health and tourist centre of northeast Bosnia. Tuzla is an educational center and is home to two universities. It is also the main industrial machine and one of the leading economic strongholds of Bosnia with a wide and varied industrial sector including an expanding service sector thanks to its salt lake tourism. The city of Tuzla is home to Europe's only salt lake as part of its central park. The history of the city goes back to the 9th century. Population numbers, a bit less than 120.000.

What to visit in case you arrive earlier:

In Tuzla you will find lots of mosques and churches to see, both orthodox and catholic. Some of them date back to **16th century** like **Atik Behram-bey Mosque and Orthodox Church.**

Pannonian Lakes -The Pannonian salt lakes are the biggest artificial salt lakes in the Europe. Tuzla is also the only city that has salt lakes, waterfalls and a beach in the centre of the city. Ticket price is 5 KM (2,5€). <https://goo.gl/KzbUa6>

Slana Banja - Slana Banja is a park in Tuzla located in the centre, which is spacious, green and with plenty of monuments from the past wars. Below Slana Banja you can find tennis courts and restaurants (Sezam & Zlatnik). <https://goo.gl/3LCrmu>

Currency

In Bosnia and Herzegovina national currency is Bosnian Convertible Marka - BAM or KM.

1 € is equal to 1.95 BAM or KM

Safety

Criminal activity is below average so it's pretty **safe to walk around even late at night.**

HOW TO GET THERE

Tuzla Airport is a small airport near the village of Dubrave Gornje, south of the city of Tuzla. By car you can reach the airport via the M18 or M4, two main roads in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Wizz Air has a base at the airport, the airline offers cheap flights to Basel Mulhouse Freiburg Airport and Gothenburg Landvetter Airport among others.



The airport is 15 kilometres from the city centre, a drive between the two places takes 25 minutes.

There is no bus service available between the airport and the city of Tuzla, you are dependent on **taxi** or **rental car**. Still, a bus runs every hour between Tuzla and Dubrave Gornje, namely bus number 11.

When you walk out of the terminal, you will see taxi drivers who pick up passengers and take them to their destination. The price of a taxi ride to Tuzla is **30 BAM (15 euro)**. Make a [taxi reservation Tuzla Airport](#) through Taxi Tender, or if you cannot make a reservation you can take a taxi outside of the airport. In case if there is not a taxi you can call one, the numbers of taxi services are 1519, 1525, 1524, 1530, 1517.



Here is a QR code of android app where you can find all of the taxi firm numbers in case it is easier for you to have them in this form.

For those who decide to travel **via Sarajevo** you have direct busses driving every hour. Return ticket costs **30 BAM** or KM which is equal to 15 €. From main bus station in Tuzla you can take Taxi directly to the venue, it will costs 2 BAM or KM which is equal to 1€. Distance between Sarajevo and Tuzla is around 120 km, and journey will take around **3 hours**.

For those participants who decide to travel **via Belgrade**, you have three busses driving every day, first one at 09:00, second one at 14:30 and third one at 16:00.

Return ticket costs **45 BAM** or KM which is equal to 23 €. Also, from main bus station in Tuzla you can take Taxi directly to the venue, it will costs 2 BAM or KM which is equal to 1€. Distance between Belgrade and Tuzla is around 200 km, and journey will take around **4 hours**.



REIMBURSEMENT

Keep ALL your ORIGINAL your tickets, boarding passes, receipts/invoices.

They will be collected during Follow Up Activity. Reimbursement will be done in EUROS regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket and receipt/invoice.

WHAT TO BRING?

In Bosnia and Herzegovina, the climate is continental, with cold winters and hot summers, in the northern plains like in Tuzla. In summer, due to the location hot days are possible with peaks of 40 °C.

Checklist:

- Comfortable clothes/shoes for inside activities;
- Swimsuit and slippers;
- SUN CREAM;
- Clothing for rainy weather (umbrella);
- Personal hygiene belongings;
- Hair Dryer if needed;
- Special medicine if needed;
- Smartphone and/or laptop would be preferable;
- Presentation of the local workshops done in home communities (target group – background, age and number of participants; topics tackled; methods used; highlights and added value of the workshop accompanied with photos/ videos).
