DESCRIPTION & OBJECTIVES

The main idea of this seminar is put together a diverse group of youth workers in the scope of rural alternatives of self-employment through tourism and environmental activities.

The whole project could be summarized in 3 parts:

- What we are doing here and why we think it is interesting.
- Real life case of study: becoming part of the project.
- Exchange of best practices between countries and organizations with intense focus on further collaboration.

The aim of project is to gather intelligence about possibilities, technologies, tactics and strategies in the way to healthy rural environments.

PARTICIPANTS

We will be joining 32 participants from 16 countries plus 5 staff member from the host organization.

Each partner organization is expected to delegate 2 persons for this training and we prefer those who are active in organization as youth workers or activists. This is because we intent to grow long-term collaboration developing technologies, sharing strategies and giving each other support. Also, we need persons with solid/good knowledge of English, older than 18.

The easiest way to reach Llerena is from Seville

Bus from Seville (**Plaza de Armas Station**). Departures at:

- 11:30
- 18.45

In the case you consider coming from Madrid, you should know the bus from there takes 6 hours.

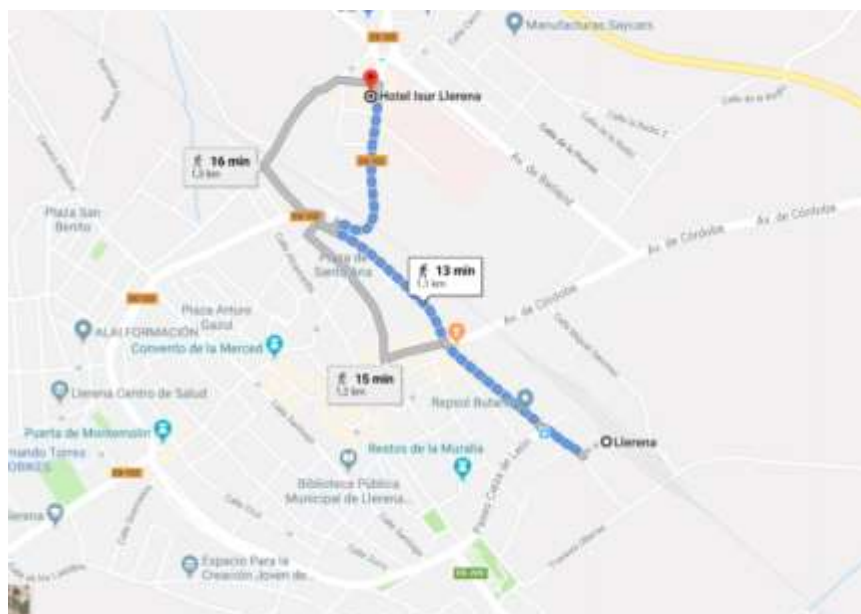
Bus from Madrid (Estación SUR – Méndez Álvaro Station). Departure at:

Any other configuration such as Málaga or Lisboa, should lead to Seville and follow the steps given above.

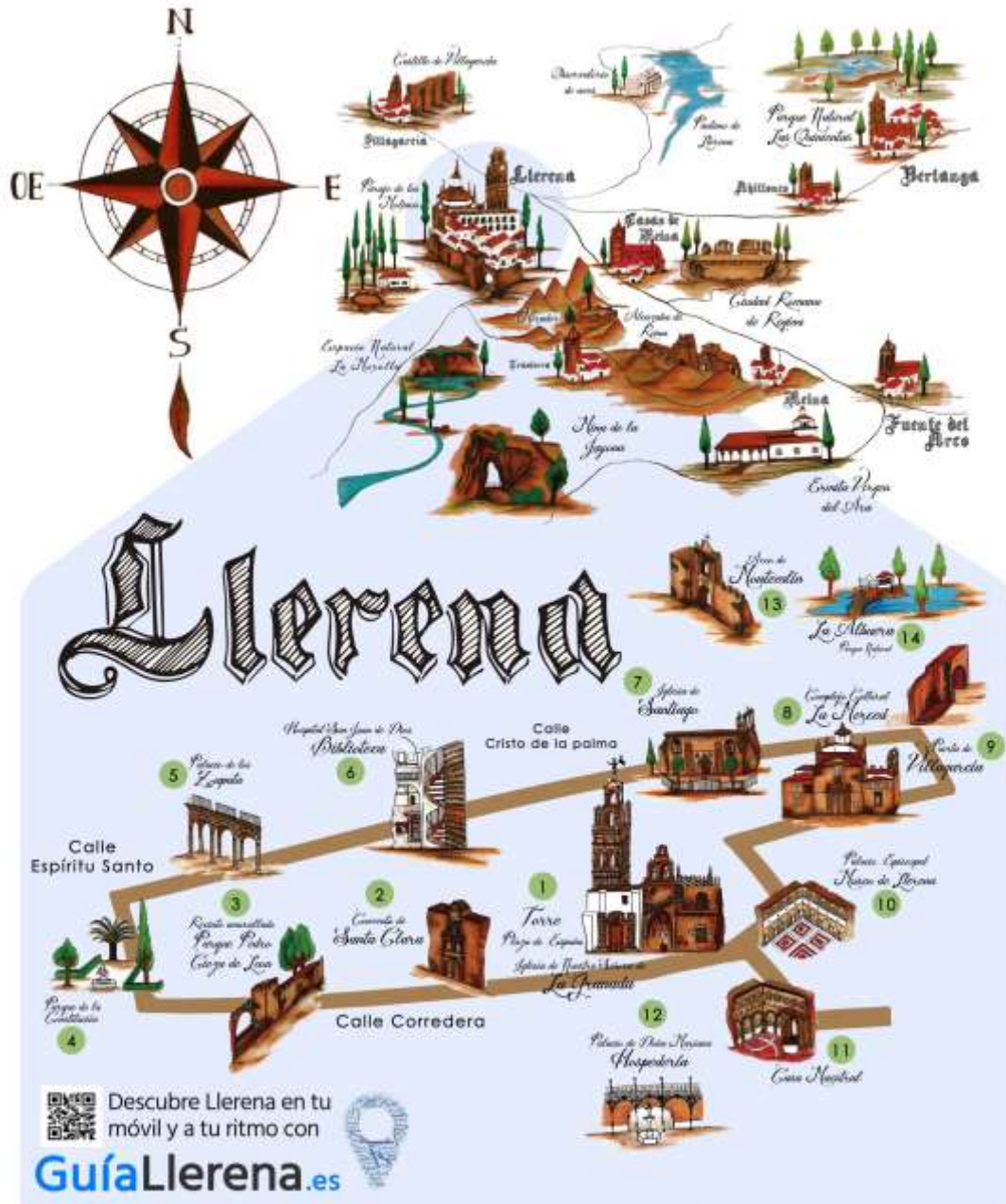
THE VENUE

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU?

THE MORE YOU BRING, THE BETTER :) Bring something to represent your country. Yes, we will have intercultural night where you will have the space to present your country; we suggest that you bring some food, drinks, flags, materials, etc. If you are already familiar with intercultural nights, you know you want to feel proud of your country ;)

- Electronic devices (we need to do research online data, we will need to take pictures, editing...)
- reasonably comfortable shoes & clothing (we will have some not-so-hard hiking)
- swimsuit and summer clothes (we will get wet a couple of times)
- Casual clothes for social situations (not too elegant but enough to reach a level you could feel comfortable at night with people)
- **Sunscreen cream**, hat, cap... Up to you. But definitely something to protect you from our unforgiving sun. You need to take into account that temperature could go beyond 40°, and we will spend time outside.
- Toiletry products.
- European health care card or any private medical insurance (in case of any unlikely event).

- You will experience an amazing walk in the dark.
- You will be judge and reporter in a gastronomy workshop.
- You will cross the "narrow sea" in kayak.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS:

INSURANCE

Before you arrive we recommend all EU/EFTA residents to obtain your free [European Health Insurance Card](#).

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT

Reimbursement will be done after receipt of all original travel documents (tickets, boarding pass and invoices, both from arrival and departure trip). Also, for full reimbursement you need to attend whole program and to respect working rules. When we receive all traveling documents, we will reimburse the amount to your sending organization via bank account. We accept up to 2 days of difference in ticket dates from the beginning/ending dates. It could be 2 days, before, 2 days after or 1 before and 1 after.

APPLICATION/DEADLINES

Each partner organisation must delegate 2 participants who should complete [this online application form](#) **before May 28th**. After that date, there will be a final and hard deadline in which unfulfilled positions will be offered in social media, open platforms and relevant e-mail lists. The final selection will be carried on **June 1st** and communicated immediately to the selected candidates.

The host organization reserve itself the right to pick a candidate if his/her profile is so good we need him/her here.

ACCOMMODATION

The accommodation, 3 meals a day and coffee breaks will be covered fully by ERASMUS+ programme. Participants will share rooms of 3 beds with shower/bathroom. Free Wi-Fi will be available, but if you already have a mobile data plan from another EU/EFTA country, you can use it in Spain without additional roaming charges.
